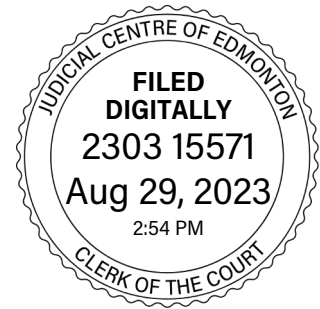

AFFIDAVIT OF RAYMOND YELLOWBIRD SHIRT

Solemnly affirmed JULY 13, 2023

I, RAYMOND NEAL SHIRT - YELLOWBIRD AFFIRM AND SAY THAT:

✓ MY FATHER IS NORMAN YELLOWBIRD, MARGARET

1. MY MOTHER IS LILLIAN ~~SHIRT~~ SHIRT, WHO TRAGICALLY PASSED AWAY SEVEN YEARS AGO. SHE WAS FROM SADDLE LAKE CREATION. I WAS BORN IN EDMONTON.

2. I HAVE STAYED OUTSIDE FOR ABOUT TWO YEARS. ABOUT TWO YEARS AGO, I WAS UP NORTH AND I BROKE UP WITH MY PARTNER. I CAME TO EDMONTON TO WORK, BUT I BROKE MY LEG AT WORK. THE DOCTORS DISCHARGED ME FROM THE HOSPITAL. I HAVE STAYED OUTSIDE SINCE THEN.

3. I HAVE GOOD FRIENDS AMONGST MY FELLOW HOMELESS NEIGHBOURS. I EXPERIENCE GOOD COMRADERY.

4. IN APPROXIMATELY ~~MAY~~ ^{JUNE} ~~AUGUST~~ 2022, I STAYED IN AN ENCAMPMENT NEAR THE HOPE MISSION. THE CITY DISPLACES ENCAMPMENTS FROM THOSE SIDEWALKS ^{HOPE MISSION COMPLAINED} ~~AND~~ THEN, AFTER I WAS DISPLACED, I MOVED NEAR THE EDMONTON POLICE SERVICE HEADQUARTERS BECAUSE AN OFFICER TOLD ME I WOULD BE OKAY AROUND THERE, BUT, I WAS EVENTUALLY DISPLACED FROM THERE TOO BY THE CITY AND/OR E.P.S.

5. FOR ABOUT ~~ONE~~ ^{THE PAST} MONTH, I HAVE HAD A TIRE PLE. I HAVE BEEN DISPLACED FOUR TIMES SINCE I'VE HAD MY TIRE PLE. EVERY TIME I HAVE LOST PROPERTY, INCLUDING SINCE I BECAME HOMELESS, I'M MY DOG KENNEL, A BIKE, A TENT, MY I.D., AND OTHER PROPERTY TO ENCAMPMENT DISPLACEMENTS.

5a) I BELIEVE HOPE MISSION ~~ACTS~~ ACTS HOSTILE TO HOMELESS PEOPLE, ESPECIALLY TO PEOPLE STAYING NEAR THEIR PROPERTY.

6. I HAVE SEEN ^{THANK IN 2-1000} A PEOPLE LEAVE THEIR ENCAMPMENT TO GET BREAKFAST ONLY TO HAVE THE CITY OF EDMONTON AND/OR EDMONTON POLICE SERVICE TAKE THEIR STUFF WHILE THEY'RE GETTING BREAKFAST.

7. LOSING PROPERTY TO ENCAMPMENT DISPLACEMENTS CAUSES PSYCHOLOGICAL INJURY, INCLUDING DEPRESSION & TRAUMA.

8. I DO NOT HAVE A PHONE. I USED TO HAVE A PHONE BUT I HAD NO PLACE TO CHARGE IT. I USE FACEBOOK.COM


9. IN ENCAMPMENTS, WE SUPPORT EACH OTHER. I BELIEVE WE DEPEND ON EACH OTHER.


10. I HAVE STAYED AT HOPE MISSION A COUPLE TIMES WHEN IT WAS -40°C. I ~~DO NOT~~ DID NOT LIKE STAYING AT HOPE MISSION BECAUSE OF BED BUGS AND I HAD MY PHONE STOLEN.

11. I DO NOT HAVE ANY SOURCE OF INCOME. I RECENTLY LOST MY I.D. WHICH IS A BARRIER TO APPLYING FOR INCOME SUPPORT. SOMETIMES, I FEEL TOO PROUD TO APPLY FOR INCOME SUPPORT.

12. GETTING DISPLACED SETS ME BACK. IT CAUSES ME WORRY AND DIFFICULTIES. THE DAY AFTER A DISPLACEMENT IS HARD. IT TAKES TIME TO RECALIBRATE AND RECOVER.
